**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FY 2019 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
BY THE TOWN OF BOWLING GREEN, VIRGINIA**

The Council of the Town of Bowling Green, Virginia (the “Council”) will hold a public hearing on the FY 2019 Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of the \$6,316,000. The proposed supplemental appropriation is to finance and refinance costs of capital improvement to the Town's water and sewer systems. The public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned and at which persons may appear and present their views on the proposed bond issuance, will be held at **7:00 p.m.** on **July 5, 2018**, or as soon after that time as the matter may be heard, before the Council in the Town Hall, located at 117 Butler Street Bowling Green, Virginia.
